Operate on auto-pilot. We are often reactionary.	Become conscious of our communication and interactions with our children. We are often able to remain amused and calm.
Judge children based on their behaviour.	Know who our children really are.
Focus on behaviour.	Focus on the driving force behind the behaviour.
Change misbehaviour short-term by using power, control and punitive discipline. We manage their behaviour.	Be our children's coach to help them find acceptable alternatives and self-correct. They learn to manage their own behavior.
Order and demand obedience. Our children become the problem, are not part of the solution and work against us.	Help our children find their own solutions and work with us as a team.
Create a relationship based on control, fear and disconnection.	Build a strong loving relationship where we remain in charge by listening, connecting, empathising and setting clear boundaries and rules.
Our children feel misunderstood, disconnected and follow our lead due to fear or punishment.	Our children feel valued, understood and respected and return our respect by listening to us and following our lead.
